Story of a student

we support

We supported Veronika for 5 years during her university studies. She had a sponsor, who regularly donated money into her savings account. During the years we have also fulfilled many of her wishes, mainly regarding her business activities. She wrote the letter a year before her graduation. Now she has successfully entered the independent life and we are still in touch.

My name is Veronika, I am 25 years old and I entered children's home 11 years ago. I ended up there due to the death of my step-father and because my mum had a nervous breakdown, started taking hard drugs and stopped taking care of us. My siblings and I didn't have anything to eat so we stole from shops just to get some food. This situation lasted more than a year, after which we were placed into the children's home. For me personally it was terribly hard, I wasn't able to adapt and I just spent time with my siblings. I tried to get out of things by claiming various illnesses so that I didn't have to go to school amongst ordinary students. This stopped after about 3 months. I started thinking about myself. I decided to start to study, I wanted to study at high school and to graduate, not just to do some kind of an apprenticeship. I tried to get good marks, and in 8th and 9th grade I achieved it. My goal at that time was to get accepted to a Police academy, but in the end, I finished up at a hoteling school. During the four years of my studies the possibility to travel abroad started to slowly open up. Thanks to the foundation's donations I was able to visit Great Britain, Estonia, Malta, Belgium, France, Italy and Croatia. Each visit to a foreign country convinced me to continue on this path. When the time for graduation came, I felt terribly stressed, I wanted to prove to myself that I could achieve „something“. When I successfully graduated, I was happy that I already achieved more than the rest of my family. The only one who was proud of me was my uncle, who I visit until this day, and myself, of course. After graduation I knew I wanted to go to university I just couldn't decide which one. I applied for various courses and tried the entrance exams, but nothing worked out. Suddenly, I realised I didn't know what to do. I knew I wasn't ready to go my own way, so the headmaster and I agreed that I would go for a year's study and prepare for the university exams meanwhile. During this period I also started to develop stomach problems. I couldn't eat, I went to several check-ups and they discovered that my problems stemmed from a bad diet and stress. It was time to change my routine. I began to take an interest in nutrition and I started to exercise regularly at home. Gradually everything began to change. I got a part-time job so that I could afford to change my eating habits and I started educating myself in this area. In the end I even looked for universities that focus on this subject. I found one, but it was in Prague and it was a private school. I approached the foundation and asked if they would be able to help me with my schooling. I got everything I wished for, I moved to Prague and started attending the chosen university. I took a Trainer and nutritional specialist course and that is all thanks to the fact that I never stopped believing in myself and that others believed in me too. I know that without these people, I wouldn't be where I am today. When you have to do everything alone, you appreciate the help that is offered, but doesn't have to be offered, far more. I am grateful to all the foundations, but LET'S GIVE CHILDREN A CHANCE is the only organisation with which I have a personal relationship. I would like to thank the whole team. Thanks to them I always felt the drive when I wanted to achieve something, because I knew that someone believed in me. Without a support from my own family, I appreciated theirs even more.

My dreams and goals now are to finish my doctorate degree, achieve the best result possible in a Czech competition in the Bikini fitness category and get my own business started, making competition bikini suits.

Who we are and what we do

We provide comprehensive assistance to children via our projects, which complement each other.

We are professional organisation providing comprehensive assistance to specific children and young people growing up in children's homes in the Czech Republic. We help them especially in the in the last years of their stay in the homes and in the beginnings of their independent lives. We are working with 42 children's homes. More than 250 children are continually included in our projects. Each child can be simultaneously supported in multiple projects. We also help children outside the children's homes (page 24–25).

Leaving the children's home for an independent life is a tremendously difficult life test for young people and it is necessary to prepare for it during their stay in the children's home.

Young people while leaving the children's home are formally adults, but still children in fact. They have no background, no example of a functioning family, they have nowhere to go, they are left to themselves. They receive a maximum amount of CZK 25,000 according to the law when leaving. Can you imagine your children in their situation?

Facilitate the successful integration into society of young people from children's homes after leaving, is in interest of all of us!

- We consult our activities with young people who grew up in children's home
- We are interested in and informing the public about the issue of children growing up outside their biological families
- We work with experts from all fields of substitute family/institutional care
- We are members of AVPO (Association of public benefit organizations)
- Each of our projects has its own bank account, company operation account is kept separately
- Each child has an individual VS (payment reference) for payments to the particular project account
- **100 % of all money sent to the projects accounts under individual children's payment references (VS) is used to support those specific children**

Forms of help provided to children

Every child can be included in multiple projects, regarding their needs.



MATERIAL SUPPORT

Justified wishes (project „I wish...”)

The children receive a product or service according to their wish, which they can personally choose. Majority of the things are assigned otherwise.

Christmas gifts for children from cooperating children's homes (project „Wishing Tree...”).

Starting packs with basic household equipment (project „Help me start in life...”).



FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Comprehensive financial support for young people during their studies (Scholarship programme as a part of the „Help me start in life...” project).

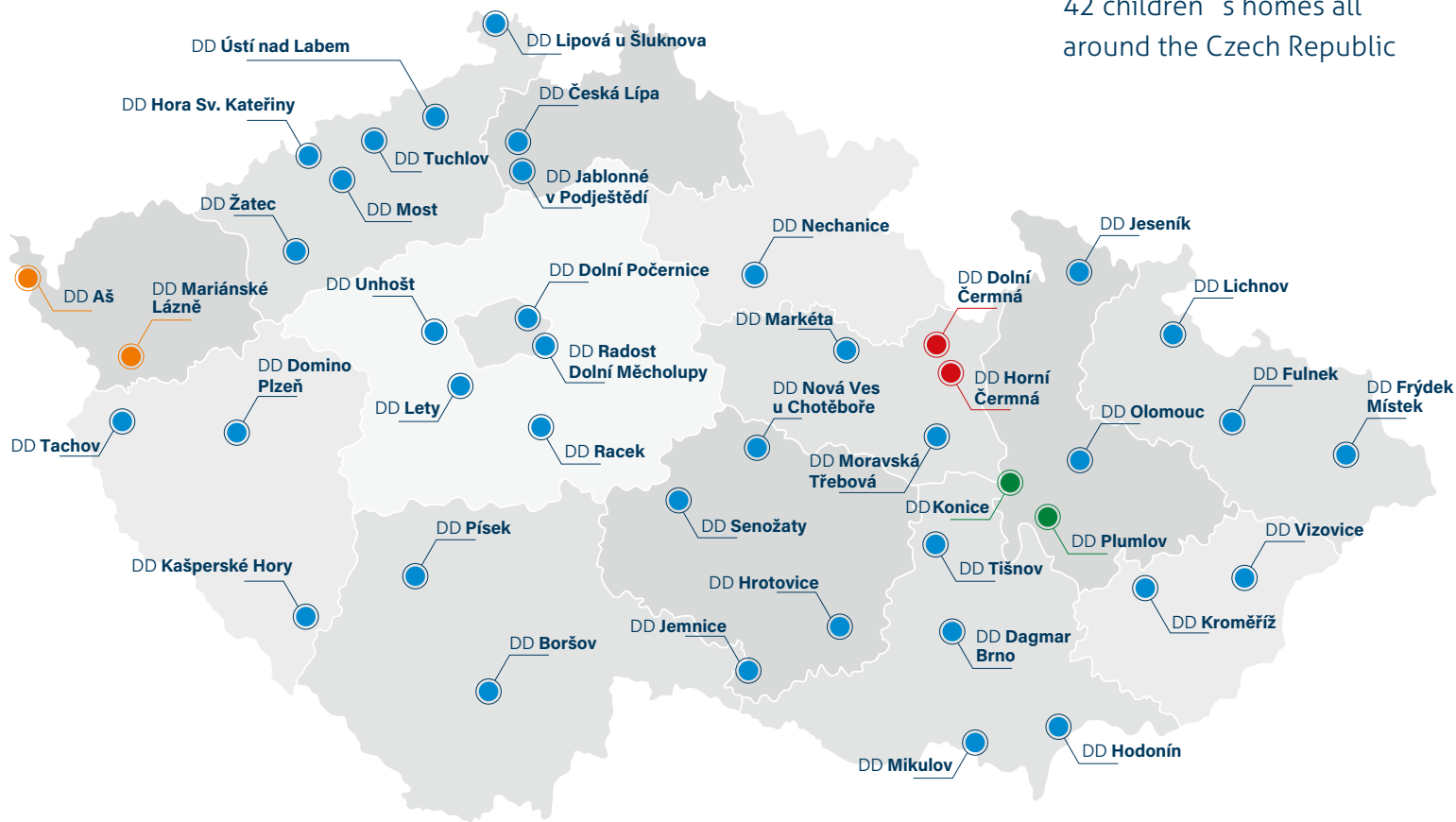

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„Support me...”

OR ADOPTION „UP CLOSE”

Motto: „Money isn't everything, but nothing is worth without it.”

The purpose of this project is to save money for children during their stay in children's homes, which become available to them after leaving the institution. This project is based on long-term financial support of a specific child, however, children can be supported on a one-time basis too. Minimum monthly contribution is CZK 200.

We discuss the inclusion of individual children within the project with the staff of the cooperating children's homes. We preferably select children who have little chance of returning to their biological families or to get a permanent placement in an substitute family. Simply, we select children who are to be alone during the transition to an independent life as that is a truly difficult life challenge.

Every child's case is dealt with individually. We discuss the usage of the saved funds with the donors. Our organisation guarantees effective use of the donor's money. In most cases, we reimburse an apartment deposit, contribute to the first rental payments and pay for basic household equipment.

Anyone can select a child to support based on their motivational letters that are published on our website. Donors may remain anonymous or can contact the supported child after agreement. In this case, we recommend to gather more in-depth information about children growing up

in institutional care. We hold host care seminars for those interested.

It is no exception that financial support is just the beginning of a long-term friendship between a donor and a child, as you can see in following stories.

„Thanks to this project, it is not only the children who are given a chance, it is us adults as well – a chance not to be indifferent and support them. I am glad that I can be a part of it and financially support little boy called Vlastík. I like to think that I give him the feeling that there is someone who cares about him and will always have his best interests at heart. His letters are a great reward to me, it is a proof that everything works well and the effort on both sides makes sense. I am truly pleased and therefore I will happily continue to contribute, support him, and keep in touch with my new friend.”

Veronika has been part of our projects for six years, five of which we have supported her whilst studying to the amount of 171 650 CZK. She is a kind person who, after finishing her cooking apprenticeship, followed by a gardening apprenticeship, prolonged her stay in children's home. Being placed in a Scholarship programme has motivated her to achieve better results at school. Veronika has proved to us how important it is to deeply connect with the children in our programmes. During our first meeting she barely spoke, was very shy and was not able to communicate with us without her friend being near. Despite her nervousness, our communication did improve after some time and Veronika began to communicate with us without any problem.

Veronika's patron, Eva Balážová, has raised 56 000 CZK which helped Veronika with the funding of her wedding with her long-term partner.

Our first meeting with Veronika was lovely, though she was a little bashful. Actually, she brought her friend with her who often spoke instead of Veronika. But as in many things in life, times have changed and Veronika has transformed from a shy girl into a confident woman, who not only took her life in her own hands but also started helping her siblings, who are also in a children's home. When Veronika asked me if she could use the money I had saved up for her for her wedding, I could not have been happier. The young man she introduced to me was really "the one," and their plans for the future were heading in the same direction. I hope Veronika's courage and perseverance won't ever leave her,

We do not register the number of children who have found their host. After the initial contact with people interested and their familiarisation with the situation, or after attending the host care seminar, we direct them straight to the children's home near their place of residence. Host care can sometimes turn into foster care, in other words, permanent integration of the child into the family.

Host care is an unknown term for many people. It means occasional visits and later, maybe weekend or holiday stays of the child in the host family. This means that it is not about finding the child a substitute family. That is why it is recommended for children over the age of ten. It can fulfill their desire to create a bond with someone outside the children's home. The children get to experience how it works in ordinary families, see models of functional relationships and communication between partners and parents with children. Ideally, this relationship lasts until the child's maturity. After leaving the children's home, the host becomes a friend, who helps the young person in this very uncertain and extremely stressful period solving common issues that the child has never faced before.

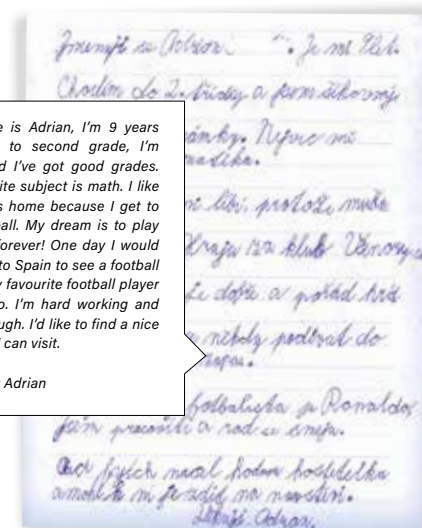
We advise all those interested in this form of help to attend host care seminars where they will learn not only how to get started but mainly more about specifics of children growing up outside their families. We recommend to really think it through and take it slowly. Everything has its own time and the relationship should develop gradually to stress neither the child nor the host.

IDEAL PROCESS OF HOST CARE CAN BE:

- Writing letter(s)
- Visiting the child in the children's home
- Taking trips (few hours at first, later all day trips)
- Inviting the child to the host family (one-day)
- Staying together over the holidays (more days)

Sometimes you have a longing to help somebody, although you are aware it may not necessarily take a material form. You just want to give somebody the feeling of being safe and secure - to show them that they are not alone in this world. Because loneliness is the worst feeling ever.

I have been helping Filip since he was 11 years old. It's a great feeling helping someone. However, he didn't see it as help at first; instead, Filip saw me as his father. Today I can't even imagine him calling me by my name. A little help at the beginning has grown into a family. I am a dad now, and I have a son. I cannot be more grateful.

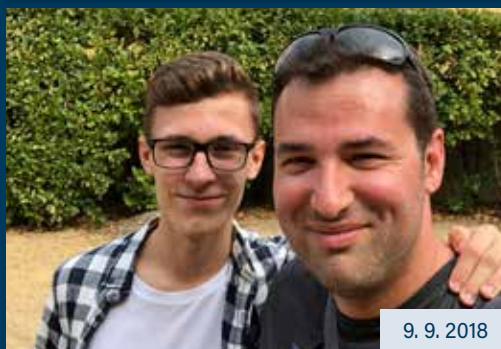

The purpose of this project is to fulfil so-called justified wishes, which must have some correlation with studies, meaningful leisure or health handicap. During the child's stay in the children's home several wishes can be fulfilled.

Andrea is one of the students we support. She is currently studying university to become dental technician. Andrea has been involved in the organisation's projects since 2012. During this time, we have fulfilled seven of her wishes worth **CZK 35 850**. In addition, we are contributing to her studies since 2015. She also has a supporter who is saving her money for an easier start in an independent life.

However, we also fulfil wishes for groups of children, e.g. admission to theatre, cinema, aquapark, etc. Every child can be a part of this project and everyone can help. The minimum amount of the support is **CZK 100** because we know that even a smaller amount of money helps to make a wish come true.

The aim of the project is to enable children to participate in the choice of their wish, they can choose products that make them happy rather than be given things they do not like or need.

„Help me start in life...” targets mainly older children and young people living in children's homes. The mission of this project is to prepare children for a start of their independent lives. Entering an independent life is unimaginably hard even for prepared individuals. That is why it is important to stay in touch with the children after they leave the children's home, so they have someone to turn to.

THE PROJECT IS DIVIDED INTO 3 SECTIONS:

- Scholarship programme
- Starting packs
- Help at the start of their independent lives

Denisa, 26

Denisa currently finished her university degree. She has been part of the organisation's projects since 2012. She had **CZK 72 550** saved on our account, which is gradually used for the beginning of her independent life. We supported Denisa for eight years through all of our projects, with a total amount of **CZK 336 707**. Denisa is a clever, responsible young lady, who was definitely well prepared to enter an independent life. We will be ready to offer her help at any time in the future.

Starter packs

When leaving the children's home, young people can get so-called „starter pack”, which is a variety of household equipment. The pack contains all the necessities such as plates, cutlery, bed linen, towels, vacuum cleaner, iron, kettle, drugstore goods for both personal hygiene and cleaning, and much more.

PROJECT RESULTS:

Starter packages:

As of June 30, 2020 we had already distributed a total of 205 Starter packages worth CZK 3 649 969.





Denisa has shared her life story with the visitors of our annual Christmas Auction.

I joined the „Help me start in life...”project during my final year at high school. I got accepted to a university in Jihlava, where I also got my bachelor's degree in Health and Social Care. Every year I am offered a part-time job within the Wishing Tree project and I help at different events as well. I am glad I can help. I appreciate what they've done and continue to do for me. I would like to thank all the people from this organisation who have taken part in my education and self-development. Thanks to you, I am ready to enter an independent life.

Scholarship programme

The aim of the programme is to support young people throughout their studies. We cover the costs related to their education in order to allow them to study the course they want. This increases their chances of achieving higher qualification and finding a job on the labour market. Students can apply for the cover of their **school tuition fees, travel costs, rent, school supplies and workshops**. Based on their grades they are also rewarded with a **merit and motivational scholarship**. The maximum amount of a student support is **CZK 50 000** per school year.

Students are admitted to the programme on an annual basis selection procedure. They must send a cover letter and attend a personal interview (in many cases, this is the first interview in their lives). The interest in the scholarship programme increases each year and the number of applicants keeps growing as well, which makes us very happy. The aim is to support young people during their studies if they meet the conditions for inclusion in the project. We organise educational weekend getaways for the students selected within this programme. We arrange various seminars, workshops and leisure activities, this gives children the opportunity to meet number of professionals from different backgrounds who pass on their knowledge. The students learn about financial literacy, employment contracts, interviews, etiquette and so much more. Besides all that we try to build a relationship and gain mutual trust between our team and the students. We stay in touch throughout the year with all our students.

PROJECT RESULTS Scholarship programme:

As of June 30, 2020 we supported 109 students within the Scholarship programme with the total amount of CZK 5 720 569.



Daniela studies Social Pedagogy at the university in České Budějovice. She enjoys photography, drawing and watching films. We have been supporting Daniela since 2014 and have managed to save up CZK 61 350 for her independent life. We have also fulfilled five of her wishes to the value of CZK 23 050 (such as a notebook necessary for her studies and a camera). Daniela is in our Scholarship programme for five years, and we have covered her school costs with CZK 57 024. The majority of this amount has been spent on school supplies and commuting.

Scholarship programme is something more than just a weekend where I get praised for my academic achievements. It motivates me to work harder to achieve my goals and push myself beyond my limits. Apart from that, I cannot forget to mention their financial support. I can't even imagine how difficult it must be to pay the expenses for every one of us; the school fees, accommodation and travel costs.

If I hadn't been selected for the Scholarship programme again, I would really miss being in touch with all the great people. I really value friendship, friends are the only people in my life I can genuinely rely on. Obviously, the financial support is also irreplaceable. Not having this outstanding support and help would cause many problems in my life. The last thing I want to say is thank you for all you have done for me, for all the opportunities which otherwise would never be possible for me to have. SEVEN YEARS AGO AND TODAY

Recently we rediscovered Roman's piece of writing which he created for a Literary competition in 2012. It is beautiful to see how our support can make dreams come true.



Roman currently finished his second year at Police Academy in Prague. In the eight years that Roman has been taking part in our projects we have also fulfilled four of his wishes; mostly health care and hobbies in the amount of CZK 22 990

Roman also has a personal patron since 2018, who is saving money for his independent start in life.

I would like to go back in time to when I was little. Unfortunately, I don't remember much of it. I do remember my mother, father and siblings though. In my memory, we are all playing together. I am trying to recall how my aunts and uncles look, but it is too long ago to remember. The time when I was already at school is much clearer to me. I was six years old, and my parents were living separately at that time. We spent most of the time at my mum's. My brother and I were always looking forward to seeing our father. I liked it there. Spending time at our dad's was great at first, he looked after us. However, one night, he didn't come home. Our aunt, who was living with us, said we had nothing to worry about. The next day, two women arrived; what we did not know back then was that they were social workers. I remember they took my brother and I to the doctor and then drove us to a children's home. We thought we would only be there for one day and then be back living with our dad. That was a serious delusion. After one month, we found out our dad was being held in prison. He wrote letters to us, but we did not see him for a very long time. One day our mum visited us. I had many questions for her, like, why am I in a children's home? Even though she explained it all, I did not comprehend any of it. Every night I wished to be back home, I missed everybody so much. Then one day became five years. In the end, I became used to living in a children's home and sharing a room with my brother helped a lot. When they released dad from prison, he came to see us many times with promises of taking us back home. Instead, he was put in jail again. We speak a little, but my hopes of going back home have disappeared. It is clear to me I will be living in a children's home until my adult years.

I like it here, and I am doing well at school and I have great friends. I love sports and I want to develop my skills in a range of sports activities, which will be beneficial when starting my future career. My goal is to be accepted to study Security Guards Services at college in Ostrava. I have good grades and excellent academic skills, so I may make my dream come true. You may ask why I want to be a policeman? Since the fifth grade, I watched documentaries about police officers, who risk their own lives to save others, guard our safety and help people. I developed a passion for this job, and I want to help all the people who need it. When I have a family of my own, I won't allow my children to go to a children's home.

Back then, I was only thirteen years old, and I already knew what I wanted to do with my future. It was a boy's dream, who maybe wanted to be different, perhaps ordinary, or to be the opposite of his father. There were so many voices in my head saying I am not good enough, but also a bunch of those who said I could make it. So I did.

I got accepted to Police Academy in Holešov. The beginning was very challenging. Suddenly I wasn't the best student in class, and I was struggling to pass my exams. Soon it all became overwhelming. However, I managed to overcome the obstacles, got to know new people, experienced new things and gained friends. At that time I was part of a great group of young people, and I definitely wouldn't change a single thing about my decisions. I gained a lot of information pertaining to police work, tried new sports and travelled to extraordinary places. The boy's wish from eighth grade didn't change at all. Working as a policeman became an exciting part of my life, but in the end I added some new things to my wish list. I am twenty years old now, and I am studying Criminology and Criminalistics in Prague. This course suits me, and I manage to do various other activities along with it. When I was in grammar school, the children's home organised for us to attend financial literacy courses and other educational programs. I didn't pay attention to this topic at the time. However, after some summer jobs, which only provided me with money, I decided to change my approach to work. I was searching for something fulfilling that would interest me, and that I could see the sense of doing it. This led me to educate myself in the financial market, along with studying Criminalistics. I have my goals ahead of me, and I am trying my best to achieve them. A huge thank you goes to you the children's home and DDŠ Foundation. Without DDŠ, sponsors, and all the people attached I wouldn't be where I am now. From educational seminars to financial support, it was all remarkably helpful.

Thank you for letting me be part of this project.

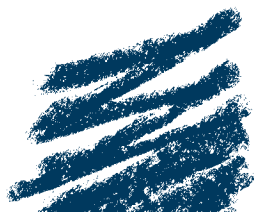

It is a form of support built on the needs of an individual. Our primary focus is on finding the most suitable accommodation and work placement, together with personal assistance when it comes to leaving a children's home. We cooperate with several companies, which makes providing job opportunities for our students more accessible.



It is a pleasure to see „our children” living their own lives, especially when they stepped into it with our support and made it work. Receiving good references from the employers only serves to increase our satisfaction.



Lukas Grundza has been employed at our restaurant since October 2015, and Patrik Balaz since 2017. Both of them worked here before as summer interns. They now work as waiters and serve meat and other dishes to our customers. At the beginning they both had a very different view on life, and I think that it took them some time before they realised one thing. It is necessary to work on self-development along with improving their approach to the job, which brings rewards and helps them fit well into the team. This would be difficult without support. However, they both became excellent members of our team. I have to admit that at the beginning even I had my doubts, but that is a long time ago. Now they are highly-valued employees. I want to mention how incredibly hard it must be to function without the reinforcement of family background... hats off! We, as employers, should have greater patience with these employee... these children often have distorted ideas of the way things work, and sometimes even bad habits. Then we become their mentors, not just employers.

Therefore, we are glad that employing Lukas and Patrik doesn't require doing so as they are more than competent.

„Children without debts“

motto: „The law is just technical and not always successful reflection of justice“

LET'S GIVE CHILDREN A CHANCE is a partner of a project „Children without debts“ founded by Mgr. Alena Vlachová, who provides legal assistance to children and young people, leading to their debt relief and preventing execution. These are mainly debts for municipal waste and fines from public transport.



Thanks to the hard work and success of Mgr. Vlachová we do not need to use all the funds within this project to relieve these children. Mgr. Vlachová therefore released **CZK 60 000** to support three girls who were placed in a facility for children in need of immediate care due to a mistake of social workers and had to leave at the age of 18 even though they were still studying.

Supporting young people outside the children's homes

We decided to expand our activities to support young people, who do not live in children's homes, but we believe they should. These are cases where children were wrongly placed in ZDVOP (a facility for children in need of immediate care), which they have to leave at the age of 18, compared to children living in children's homes, who can stay until the age of 26 if they study. We have therefore decided to support three girls and include them into our projects. The first one was brought to our attention by one of the students in our Scholarship programme. Soon, she was followed by two sisters in the same situation. Fortunately, these girls have the opportunity to live in subsidized housing, but they had to pay all the costs of living themselves, even though they were still just high school students!

All three of them were placed into an institutional care at the age of 17. They were not given a choice to decide an institutional facility with regard to their individual situation.

As mentioned previously, all the girls are currently studying high school and they have the ambition to continue their studies and get higher education. In cooperation with Mgr. Alena Vlachová, who provided funding from the "Children without debts" project, we were considering a lawsuit against the state.

In 2018 all three girls passed the tender procedure and were admitted to the Scholarship programme, which covers all the costs of their studies, including school supplies and travel costs. We have given them Starter packs so they could equip their homes better. We are pleased that we have managed to find them supporters, who are saving them money. Because of their situation, we pay them a fraction of the saved money in a form of monthly allowance. We also fulfilled a few smaller wishes for all three girls, mainly concerning meal vouchers, food, fares and also English lessons.

In the future, we want to extend the support based on individual requests of young people who find themselves in similar situation to these girls, as well as supporting young people living in children's homes with whom we have no long-term cooperation. We are newly providing accommodation for our students in a rented apartment, which could also be used as a temporary housing for young adults leaving an institutional care.

Who knows how many young people find themselves in the same situation?



Ema, 19

I am a client of Samovka Center's programme "Starting accommodation" for almost two years now. My twin sister and I are on the second level of this programme.

Soon after becoming adults we transferred from a children's facility providing urgent help (Klokanek) to the first level at the Samovka Center; it was a simulation of living independently. We had to organise everything by ourselves, we didn't have another option. Moreover, the allocated social worker was concentrating more on the outcome being beneficial to our mother rather than to us. Therefore, Samovka has been a real lifesaver for us and we are glad we got this chance.

We were only eligible for a monthly contribution, which was at that time the amount of 700 CZK, and that was inadequate. The contribution then grew to the amount of 1000 CZK. We are not entitled to receive any other help, because of the orphan's pension. We took part-time jobs alongside our studies. This was our only income to cover basic needs, such as clothing and school supplies. Therefore, we were struggling with financial problems. And then we discovered the DDŠ.

Thanks to the financial help and especially the outstanding attitude of ladies from this foundation, we are finally able to afford new clothes, school supplies, and other things young women need. I do appreciate the support of DDŠ, and it is a tremendous relief. If everything goes well, I would like to pursue my studies at university.

Míša, 19

I am currently studying medical school. My story is a little different in comparison to the others, as I have never been placed in a children's home even though I believe it would have been better for me in many ways.

When I was at grammar school, I was living with my mother, two brothers and my grandparents. I have fairly irresponsible mother, so you can imagine what it was like. The thing I remember the most is being dragged by her and her so-called friends around as they got drunk. It was horrible. On top of that she couldn't, and to this day still can't, handle money very well so visits from executors and reminders to pay the rent weren't unexpected. She was very lucky to have such amazing parents who saved her every time. If it weren't for them, I have no idea where I would be right now.

My biggest problems emerged when I was in eighth grade, when my mother found herself a new boyfriend. It's a very painful topic for me but I will try to explain what happened. I didn't pay any attention to him

at the beginning, I didn't care if he was going out with my mother or not. He started to notice me though, and that's when I started to worry. After the first incident, I started avoiding him as much as possible. The worst part was that no one believed me. It was a year later when a friend of mine helped me to find the confidence to report him to the police.

My mother was shocked but she supported me at first. Then we found out that the case is being deferred and she turned her back on me. When I started high school, my mum started seeing this man again. I couldn't understand it. My grandparents had moved to their country house and I was stuck at home with him, which was the last place where I wanted to be. I often stayed out until 2 a.m. to avoid him. One time, I came home when he was there...and he did it again. I decided to solve the incident through social care. They helped me file a criminal complaint and placed me in a social living. Soon I turned 18 and I had to leave and find another accommodation which triggered my financial problems. At the moment I am living in Sámovka centre, struggling to cover majority of my expenses. I wish I had the choice to live in a children's home, where I wouldn't have to worry about food and clothing and I could focus on my studies.

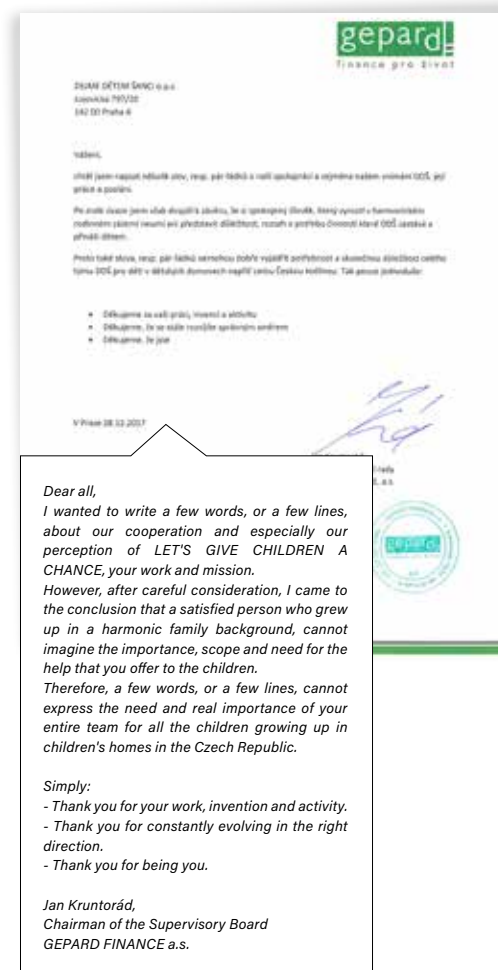
Surprise, surprise...

Gaming for a good cause

PlayStation supported young people from children's homes

Sony PlayStation has organised two 24-hour charity streams dedicated to our organisation. During the all-day live broadcast, sixteen different gamers appeared in front of the camera to support a good cause. For example internet producer **Kazma**, rapper **Ektor**, actor **Jakub Štáfek** and game streamer **Agraelus**. All of them tried to attract as many viewers and fans as possible to watch the live stream and motivate them to contribute through a payment gateway or bank transfer.

In 2018, the gamers raised an unbelievable amount of CZK 476 425 and we were shocked when they nearly doubled the amount the following year raising CZK 912 535. The proceeds of the live streams are intended to finance the project „Help me start in life...”

SONY PlayStation also donated prizes worth more than **CZK 100 000** to the viewers who decided to support the project. The first prize was the PlayStation 4 Pro 500 M Limited Edition, which was given to a donors who contributed the highest amount!

The check was received by our representatives and Richard, whom we support during his studies.

We believed that thanks to our large community of gamers, we could raise a decent amount. But honestly we didn't even hope that we would reach nearly half a million Czech crowns. Leaving the children's home and integrate into society is extremely hard. We are happy to support a project that helps these people. Big thanks to all the gamers and influencers who willingly supported our idea without claiming a fee. Most of all, we would like to thank all the donors who have shown an incredible will to help others and have shown the power of today's gaming community.

Financing of LET' S GIVE CHILDREN A CHANCE

We do not draw any funds from government subsidies and ESF!

Our priority is not to be dependent on grants, not having to adapt our thought-through projects to them and be able to adapt our projects to current needs of the young people we support.

Since the beginning, the funding of our organisation relies on the support of individuals, corporate donors and charitable foundations.

Each of our projects has a separate bank account. All funds transferred to the accounts under specific variable symbols are used solely to support the specific children within the projects.

The operational account of the organisation, related to operational costs as well as administration of the projects, is maintained separately.

All LET' S GIVE CHILDREN A CHANCE accounts are maintained at Raiffeisenbank a.s., branch Národní 9, Prague 1.

All donations and contributions are published on our websites (unless the donor wishes to remain anonymous).

Donors' contributions over CZK 10 000 are presented in the annual reports.

We put emphasis on efficient and effective use of all donated funds.

Operational costs are partially covered by self-financing. Organising events and the sale of promotional items has also a non-financial benefit for us. It is an opportunity to present our activities and find new supporters for the organisation or specific children from children's homes.

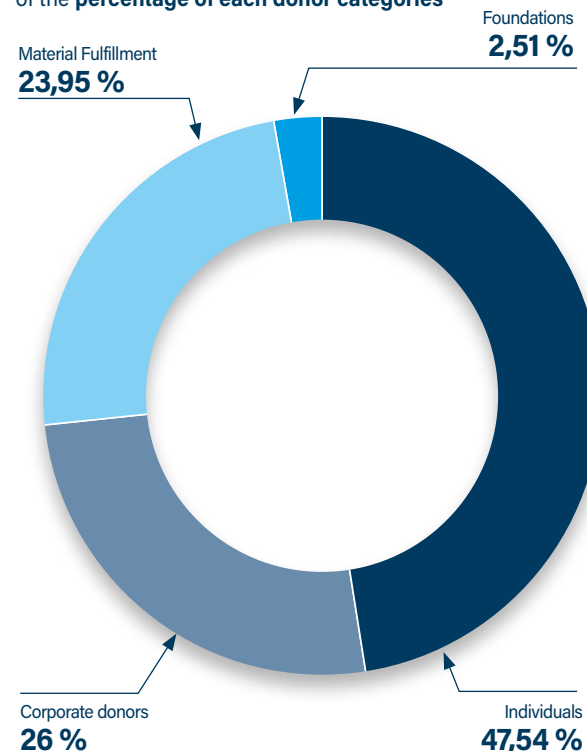
LET' S GIVE CHILDREN A CHANCE is a holder of the Reliable Non-Profit Organisation label, which we repeatedly vindicate.

Our accounting is audited annually.

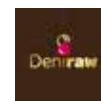
